2. That the firm will manufacture only permitted drugs and not any intermediate for their sale/distribution and also maintain all the records as per "Good Manufacturing Practices" laid down under Schedule M & as per Schedule U of Drugs & Cosmetics Rules, 1945.
3. That the products of the firms will not resemble with the name, packing, design and color of the products of any other firm/firms in the country.
4. That the firm will test all the raw-material and finished products in its own testing laboratory. Only those tests will be got done from the outside approved laboratories which require sophisticated instruments.
5. The firm shall submit certified copy of test reports of first three batches of each product to this office before their release for sale/distribution in the market

CONDITIONS OF LICENSE

1. The Licence and any certificate of renewal in force shall be kept on the approved premises and shall be produced at the request of an Inspector appointed under Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.
2. Any change in the technical staff named in the Licence shall be forthwith reported to the Licensing Authority.
3. If the licensee wants to manufacture for sale additional items of drugs not included above, he should apply to the Licensing Authority for the necessary endorsement as provided in Rule 69(5). This Licence will be deemed to the categories so endorsed.
4. The licensee shall inform the Licensing Authority and/or Central Licensing Approving Authority in writing in the event of any change in the constitutions of the firm operating under the license. Where in the event of any change in the constitutions of the firms take place the current Licence shall be deemed to be valid for maximum period of three months from the date on which the change has taken place unless, in the meantime, a fresh Licence has been taken from the Licensing Authority and/or Central Licence Approving Authority in the name of the firm with the changed constitution.
